Needed items:

- Diapers of all sizes (adult sizes as well)
- Baby food
- Baby formula
- Personal hygiene items (toothpaste, shampoo, deodorant, baby wipes, body wash, etc)
- Basic first aid supplies (band-aids, antibacterial ointment, etc)
- New socks of all sizes
- Coloring books/supplies
- Children's books or other small toys
- heavy duty garbage bags (kitchen Size and 30ga. black bags)
- prepared lunch foods
- coffee creamer
- ground coffee
- to-go coffee cups
